



## Camper Code of Conduct 2021

This code is in effect from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 2021.

### **Campers:**

Quinte's Isle Campark welcomes you back! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and gloves or hand sanitizer for the occasion that you will need it.

This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names on your occupancy agreement. Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately and your Licence of Occupation will be cancelled immediately.

If you have a fever or flu-type symptoms, please stay home. **If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days.**

**If you are returning from travel outside of the Province of Ontario, do not plan to visit the campground for a period of 14 days. Visit [www.hpepublichealth.ca](http://www.hpepublichealth.ca) for public health guidelines.**

At this time, we will be operating under the following rules. These rules may change as the Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation.

**Current Instructions from the Hastings Prince Edwards Public Health Unit Re: Seasonal Camping during the current Stay-At-Home Order.**

**Multiple residences and moving (the word ‘residence’ will also apply to a seasonal recreational unit for the purposes of this ruling)**

- i. The individual intends to be at the residence for less than 24 hours and is attending for one of the purposes set out in this Order, or
- ii. The individual intends to reside at the residence for at least 14 days.
  - With a full season contract those individuals (seasonal campers) can only come to the campground either for
    - Less than 24 hours for a reason set out in the Stay-At-Home Order or
    - Can come to the campground for at least 14 days or more.
  - If they come and stay: They cannot leave the campground for 14 days unless for emergency purposes. You may leave for essential purposes such as buying food, gas, drugstore needs, etc. and are asked to shop in our local area to avoid zone crossing.
  - If they leave the campground to go back to their principal residence after 14 days or more, they must then stay at their principal residence again for at least 14 days before coming back to the campground.
  - It is understood that these rules in place make it convenient and sometimes difficult, but they are set out under the Stay-At-Home Order under “Multiple Residences” and campgrounds would fall under this rule.
  - Once the Stay-At-Home Order is lifted in our region, then they would be able to freely move between residences without these restrictions.
  - Please know that the Stay-At-Home Order will be in place until June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, and then an assessment will be made to determine whether it can be lifted.
  - All of our public health inspectors communicate with their campgrounds in their area of inspections so other campgrounds that wish to open for the seasonal will also be following the same rules as mentioned.

## **NO VISITORS**

Until further notice, only people whose names are listed on the Licence of Occupation will be permitted in Quinte's Isle Campark.

## **COMMON AREAS**

The following common areas are closed until further notice. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification. Please call 613-476-6310

- All playgrounds, rec hall, gazebo, pergola, snack-bars, office, store, washrooms, laundry, pools, splash-pad, tennis courts, basketball court, multi-court at Pebble beach and beach

## **WALKING AROUND THE CAMPGROUND**

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules as mandated by the Province of Ontario. Currently, you must stay 2 metres or 6 feet away from other campers. You may use walking trails if social distancing rules are followed.

## **CHILDREN AND/OR UNDER THE AGE OF 16**

We expect that all parents will ensure their children will obey the rules at all times. Children should be accompanied by an adult at all time when off-site. This includes activities such as bicycling and walking.

## **LIMIT OF CAMPERS IN AN AREA**

Campers are expected to respect and obey all Provincial Guidelines (Stay-at-home-order). Social distancing and gathering rules must be followed at all times.

## **SUPPLIES**

Our store and office will be closed to walk in traffic at this time. You can also call the office for curbside or drop off service. We have propane, firewood, store, RV and camping supplies.

## **OFFICE/STORE**

The office is closed to walk-in traffic. Please use our website for online payments. Alternatively, we have set up a mailbox outside of the office for cheques and any other correspondence. We can still be reached by telephone and email.

**RESPECT OF OTHERS AND STAFF**

All Customers, guests and staff are responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment. We will not tolerate, ignore or condone discrimination or harassment and we are committed to promoting respectful conduct, tolerance and diversity at all times

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK**

I/We \_\_\_\_\_ acknowledge that:

1. I am currently not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, nor have I had COVID-19 symptoms in the last 14 days.
2. I have not travelled outside of Canada or in an area under travel health advisory in the last 14 days.
3. I have not provided care or had close contact with any person with COVID-19 or with any person reasonably suspected of having COVID-19 or with any person who travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days or with any person who travelled in an area under a travel health advisory in the last 14 days.
4. I represent and warrant to the Releasees (Quinte's Isle Campark) that I have not been advised by the Government of Canada or Ontario Public Health or my doctor or the Ontario Ministry of Health website to self-isolate due to the possible exposure to COVID-19.
5. I am fully aware of the risks and hazards with respect to COVID-19 inherent in my attendance at the Premises and participation in the activities of the Campground.
6. I freely and voluntarily agree to assume the risk with respect to COVID-19, including the risk of death, bodily injury or property damage, regardless of severity, that I (or my co-owner or ward) may sustain as a result of my participation in the activities of the Campground or attendance at the Premises, howsoever arising, including, but not limited to, the active or passive negligence of the Releasees (Quinte's Isle Campark).
7. I will practice social distancing of at least 2m while in the Campground and if not possible to do so will wear a face covering over my nose and mouth.

I understand that there are inherent and unforeseen risks involved in participating in the activities of the Campground or while attending the Premises. I have read this document in its entirety and fully understand its terms. I understand that I am giving up substantial legal rights by signing below, including the right to sue the Releasees (Quinte's Isle Campark). I acknowledge that I am signing this agreement freely and voluntarily and intend my signature to be a waiver and complete and unconditional release of all liability due to the negligence of the Releasees (Quinte's Isle Campark) or, the inherent risks of participating in the activities of the Campground or while attending the Premises.
